• **Required Documents to Bring:**

- Birth Certificate
- Income verification (last 6 months)
- Social Security Card
- I.D. or Driver's License
- Public Assistance Records/Printout
- Verification of Selective Service Registration (males born after 1960)

Sessions will last 3-4 hours. Reading & Math test will be administered. Must be able to stay for entire time.
